The foundation was founded in 2017 and operates in Tanzania and Kenya. The foundation's goal is to provide education to underprivileged Maasai children. This not only improves their personal situation, but also that of the Maasai people as a whole.

What we do:

The foundation supports underprivileged Maasai children in remote villages in northern Tanzania and southern Kenya. With your donation, you make it possible for them to go to school (again). This also helps to prevent child marriages and female genital mutilation (FGM), and gives boys more opportunities for the future than just herding cows and goats.

The foundation is looking for donors for its education projects in Kenya and Tanzania.

In addition to the sponsored Maasai children at the primary school in Sakala in northern Tanzania, Maasai children at the primary school in the village of Oloolaimutia in southern Kenya are also sponsored. The foundation works closely with local representatives and monitors the progress and quality of the children's studies and health. A number of children will also pursue a secondary school education. Just like Joyce, who started at the Peace House Secondary School in Arusha (Tanzania) in 2022, and Charity, who will start at the Ole Tipis Girls' School in Narok (Kenya) in 2024.

In January 2024, she will be attending the seventh and final grade of the Bright English Medium School in Sakala, Tanzania.

Oloningo

This Maasai boy spent half a year in the hospital in 2014 due to severe burns to his right arm. Fortunately, his recovery went well. In 2016, we visited a remote settlement (boma) where he was busy herding cattle every day. He made an unhappy and malnourished impression on us then. In consultation with the family, it was decided to give him a chance to go to school. In 2017, he started in the kindergarten class of the Bright School in Sakala. He started learning to count and studying Swahili and English for the first time there. Oloningo is already going to the sixth grade in 2024 at the age of 15.
